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Lessons from the Lockdown

With so much time to devote to the Lord, I was moved to go to Isaiah and Jeremiah again. The final judgments of Israel are given by these prophets before they are removed from the land and Jerusalem and the temple destroyed. Her sins were cataloged by the prophets. It is very easy to compare us to Israel. If she was headed to judgment, we are on a speeding bullet to a greater judgment. Israel had the light; America had the light. Yet, like Israel, America has turned from the Lord. In defiance, she has struck down God's laws: life is no longer sacred, kill the old and the preborn in greater numbers than Israel. Rob, kill and destroy in greater numbers with drugs is a large part of this sin, removing any remorse and the people love to have it so. Those who openly attend church and claim Christianity openly make laws protecting abortion and murder. Sexual sin is far more rampant than in Israel. They have struck down our laws or changed our laws to put these sins above the law, even praise them and take pleasure in them that do them (*Who knowing the judgment of God, that they which commit such things are worthy of death, not only do the same, but have pleasure in them that do them. Rom 1:32*) Now violence stalks the land and these violent men and women are protected by the 'law'.

Why would God judge us? "If God spared not" his own son from our judgment for sin (Rom 8:3); if God spared not the natural branches, the Jews, from judgment (Rom 11:21); if God spared not the angels that sinned (2 Pe 2:4); and if God spared not the old world and flooded it but saved Noah (2 Pe 2:5), Paul is saying that He will not spare the guilty in the time of His coming! Our sins are greater than Israel. I read that Israel killed about 1 million of their children to idols. America has killed at least 5 million of her children. One organization, started by Margaret Sanger and Planned Parenthood to control population and get rid of the unfit by birth control, have murdered countless children and used sex education to rob America of her moral fiber. Now our memorials are being destroyed and an attempt is being made to destroy America and her freedom. The bad news is a resurgence of the pestilence is moving throughout the world.

In Matthew 24:3, the disciples asked Jesus, 'What shall be the sign of your coming?' Jesus answered in Matt 24:4-8 *Take heed that no man deceive you. 5 For many shall come in my name, saying, I am Christ; and shall deceive many. 6 And ye shall hear of wars and rumors of wars: see that ye be not troubled: for all these things must come to pass, but the end is not yet. 7 For nation shall rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom: and there shall be famines, and pestilences, and earthquakes, in divers places. 8 All these are the beginning of sorrows.*"

The warning gets worse in v. 9 & 10. Jesus also said, *Then shall they deliver you up to be afflicted, and shall kill you: and ye shall be hated of all nations for my name's sake. And then shall many be offended, and shall betray one another, and shall hate one another.* Beloved, now a call has gone out into the land to destroy not only or national monuments but 'the white Jesus,' to destroy churches and crosses. The time of persecution as Jesus said is beginning after the beginning of sorrows. Hatred has been sown in the land and it is raging.

But in verse 13, Jesus said, '*But he that endures to the end will be saved!*' Now is the time to stand strong, to resolve to overcome and hold fast that which you have and let no man take your crown. Do not fear, the Lord has all things in His control. Has He ever failed? NO. What are His promises:

Rev 2:7 To him that overcomes will I give to eat of the tree of life, which is in the midst of the paradise of God.

Rev 2:11 He that overcomes shall not be hurt of the second death.

Rev 2:17 To him that overcomes will I give to eat of the hidden manna, and will give him a white stone, and in the stone a new name written, which no man knows saving he that receives it.

Rev 2:26-28 And he that overcomes, and keeps my works unto the end, to him will I give power over the nations:

And he shall rule them with a rod of iron; as the vessels of a potter shall they be broken to shivers:

even as I received of my Father. And I will give him the morning star.

Rev 3:12 Him that overcomes will I make a pillar in the temple of my God, and he shall go no more out: and I will write upon him the name of my God, and the name of the city of my God, which is new Jerusalem, which cometh down out of heaven from my God: and I will write upon him my new name. Alleluia!

Dear John & Eileen, thank you for making your Bible Study Correspondence Course available to inmates! It feels great to know that people still care enough to provide an education to us! John, I enjoyed your testimony. I grew up outside of Boston in a city named Lowell, where crime, gangs, drugs, violence was on every corner and in every home. It was a way of life. I have wasted many years in and out of prison selling narcotics, getting stupid, messing with bad women, chasing money , jewelry, cars etc. The whole time I was never happy, fooled by the Devil. Now I ride for God and Jesus the real Boss - The Boss of ALL Bosses. The high of the highest! Praise God! I was the victim of violent home invasion on Dec. 20, 2019, where I was zip-tied, pistol whipped, tortured, beaten and stabbed. Left for dead, I almost bled out and died in front of my 19 year old son. I got arrested Jan, 2, 2020, one week after the hospital. I could not breathe when I got arrested. I got down on my knees and I asked God for help. He spoke and told me to get an education and help sinners come to him and Jesus! I want to become a pastor or preacher! Do you know of any colleges for inmates. I want a degree and I got time to do it!!! I am totally impressed by your short testimony. I get a natural high when I did this whole bible study. When I am writing this letter, I got a feeling that right now, I am in the place that I am supposed to be!!! David NH

Rogers Testimony

About 5-6 months ago I asked for prayer because I was going to the hospital for a fourth operation on my heart. Thank you. In the last year I have spent about 3 months at Sterling CI and the rest in the hospital or at a prison infirmary.

The last two operations were really the same operation. The first time they tried to do the operation, the lacerated my artery. I almost bought the farm without money! It took 2 months for me to be strong enough for them to try again.

When I met with the cardiac surgical team, we went over everything they wanted to do and what I could expect. When they asked me if I had any concerns, I told them no. I told them I trusted them to do their best and everything else I put in my God's hands. Three and a half hours into the operation they stopped and got me into recovery. When I came around I asked how everything went and they gave me the news. They could not achieve any success whatsoever. I told them I actually felt worse. I was having a great deal of trouble breathing. They were deeply concerned and they could not tell why I had a smile on my face. Don't you remember what I told you? I put my life in God's hands and his will was being done. They were embarrassed by their failure and terrified what the result would be.

Our God is so wonderful! They took me to have a CAT scan done to my heart to see what was going on. This I was awake for and watched their faces as the scan was folded before them. By the end they were sullen and I asked what was going on. They had pierced both my pulmonary artery and my heart and now I had a blood clot the size of a golf ball on my heart. Well, it is now four and a half months since that surgery. I believe my trust in God was rewarded. A surgery that was going to make my life better, almost cost me my life. I am now better than I have been in almost 12 years. I keep getting better. Praise God and thank you for your prayers.

I just want to say "Thank you". This bible study has brought me to tears and also has put a radiant smile on my face, because of it's content and how you stress the importance of our Lord's word. Though being raised a Catholic, I have always believed in the Holy Spirit and his function in our church and us individually. Yes, I believe in the fruits of the Holy Spirit and His gifts. I have been ridiculed by many for these beliefs but I will not waver. God always was, and is, and will for ever be. Amen. Roger

Greetings from "Released to Love" Women's Recovery Group. The COVID virus has had its impact on us, too. Along with the state mandates, we also quarantined. The meeting was temporarily closed since the Little Lambs Ministry building was shut down. Several of us stayed in touch by phone, supporting each other that way. After restrictions were eased, we realized we needed the fellowship of in-person meetings and our recovery material, which us '12 Steps for Christians' with the Scriptures. Through prayer and a group decision we were able to continue the meetings outside in May with restrictions. With no access to the ministry building, our only option was to meet outside. We shortened the meeting to one hour, brought our own chairs and water, and kept an appropriate distance as we sat outside for our meeting. What a joy it was to come together as sisters in Christ! We had wonderful meetings even with the distractions of birds, airplanes, people passing by, barking dogs and cold weather. Yes, a cool front in Florida one Thursday evening.

Distractions aside, we still were able to feel the presence of the Lord. With the Lord's help, we were able to appreciate the lessons we studied and the honest sharing of each one of us. We have since moved back inside, maintaining appropriate distance and no touching, just in time for the rainy season. Our meeting is Thursdays from 6 to 7:30 pm. We have realized how important the meetings are when we were unable to meet.

Recovery takes commitment: to the Lord, to ourselves, meeting every week, working the steps, and sharing honestly with each other. We are studying Step 5 and the related scripture says "Therefore confess your sins to each other and pray for each other so that you may be healed. James 5:16.

If you want a place to learn how to really love someone without guilt and pain, come to our meeting. Because we are truly free in Christ, we wish you a very blessed Fourth of July and pray that if you feel the need, come and join us at this special meeting for women. You will be loved.
