They grow sleek and fat. 5 They aren't always in trouble and plagued with problems like everyone else, 6 so their pride sparkles like a jeweled necklace, and their clothing is woven of cruelty! 7 These fat cats have everything their hearts could ever wish for! 8 They scoff at God and threaten his people. How proudly they speak! 9 They boast against the very heavens, and their words strut through the earth.
- 10 And so God's people are dismayed and confused and drink it all in. 11 "Does God realize what is going on?" they ask. 12 "Look at these men of arrogance; they never have to lift a finger-theirs is a life of ease; and all the time their riches multiply."
- 13 Have I been wasting my time? Why take the trouble to be pure? 14 All I get out of it is trouble and woe-every day and all day long! 15 If I had really said that, I would have been a traitor to your people. 16 Yet it is so hard to explain it-this prosperity of those who hate the Lord. 17 Then one day I went into God's sanctuary to meditate and thought about the future of these evil men. 18 What a slippery path they are on-suddenly God will send them sliding over the edge of the cliff and down to their destruction: 19 an instant end to all their happiness, an eternity of terror. 20 Their present life is only a dream! They will awaken to the truth as one awakens from a dream of things that never really were!
- 21 When I saw this, what turmoil filled my heart! 22 I saw myself so stupid and so ignorant; I must seem like an animal to you, O God. 23 But even so, you love me! You are holding my right hand! 24 You will keep on guiding me all my life with your wisdom and counsel, and afterwards receive me into the glories of heaven!
- 25 Whom have I in heaven but you? And I desire no one on earth as much as you! 26 My health fails; my spirits droop, yet God remains! He is the strength of my heart; he is mine forever!
- 27 But those refusing to worship God will perish, for he destroys those serving other gods. 28 But as for me, I get as close to him as I can! I have chosen him, and I will tell everyone about the wonderful ways he rescues me.

Dear John & Eileen, M name is Dye, and I'm currently serving time in Woodbury, Ia. I was arrested November, 2021, on Felon in Possession of a Fire Arm and Drug Possession and it was my 3rd felony. So I was looking at the habitual felon which is 15 years plus Federal Prison time. I started going to the church service they provide here at our jail. And I honestly believe God is truly working for me. Instead of the 15 years in Federal Prison the judge gave me 15 years suspended, 3 years probation and residential drug treatment. I was given one of your books called "I'm Not Coming Back the John Sala Story". I laid in my bunk reading your book and it was a very amazing book to read. It has definitely inspired me to continue my search for God and to continue to see what God's plan is for my future. I have some really good plans to continue going to church with my mother once I'm out of jail. This has been an eye opener and a true blessing from my Lord and Savior, the man I call God. I would really like to thank you for the way your book has inspired me. Just like you at one time, I was on a path of destruction and not caring who I hurt on my way down. I saw your information in the back of this book and I would really like to stay in contact with you. You are truly inspiring to me. I want to take this time to say Thank You so very much for all you have done for me through these Bible Studies. I can't put into words what these studies have meant to me.

I guess I'll put this way - it's caring, loving Christian people as your selves who make this world a better place and I'm a better person because of what you did for me Thank you from my heart. Carl Dear John, Well I hustled up a soup and bought a piece of lined paper and an envelope so I can write you. I came across something that I need a man of God's advice and need a person that has access to the internet to know if something is of or not of God. In jail today they give the men a tablet. It's not the tablet I question, this tablet is censored with what is viewed or even what is said. It always 0% swear words, not a single swear word. No one is allowed to view porn or talk potty talk. They are very strict on what can be said. The tablet is de-



signed to keep fighting down. It keeps the men occupied with censored movies and what I came across and I need to find out is a series called TYRO. It's a Latin word meaning 'soldier' and they focus on the positives of getting off welfare and becoming a strong, honest man who raises the children with the difficulties of being released from prison and doing only the right things and maintaining being honest and successful with integrity. I'm being uplifted by listening to them on a daily basis. I'm trying to follow the series and do my godly work as well as such as praying with a whole heart and with God's love all at the same time. I guess what I'm asking are these people being real and honest about their life building skills. I guess what my real concern is are they of God or not. They never mention anything about God but boy o boy, they talk the talk of being a good and honest inmate to a good and honest man when released. So if you don't mind, can you please look up "TYRO". It's a prison series designed for inmates only. Well it's also designed for the family on the outside. There are 2 sides that struggle with prison life, the family that lives and works outside as well as the inmate father on the inside. So if you don't mind please look this series up and see if I, being a man of God, should or should not be watching this. I'm hoping that I'm ok too for the very reason that they have great advice for men being released from prison and some great life skills. Anyway if you've been praying for me "DON'T STOP". I'm feeling a little better very day. I'm enjoying some TYRO advice, prayer, and of course 'FOOTBALL'! Love Eddie

Yes, we looked this up for Eddie and it's a great site, helping him grow as a man.

Dear Salas, I was called to ministry at 15. God called me into His service. I went my own path from 15 to 29. November, 2018, I was picked up by the Feds. I was sentenced to 70 months. I go home from Feds in 23-24. but there was a warrant out in Florida for Aggravated Battery with a firearm and possession of a firearm, so I was transferred here in October, 2020. I'm facing 2 life sentences. I have trial soon. I'm a veteran. I'm innocent, so please pray for me. I have been serving God faithfully from Father's Day, 2019. I started a church in the Feds in Oklahoma and Pennsylvania. When I was in Pa, God told me I was going to Florida and He was planting a light there with me. Tonight is our 150th meeting straight. I missed one day from Covid (terrible). We meet every night. We have from 4 to 13 guys. We have had conversions to Christ, dedications to sobriety, professions of faith. Everyday I use the breath in my lungs to speak of God's goodness. He is faithful and true! He said He would plant a light here in jail and how bright is that light! Blessed by the name of the Lord!!JP *Join us in prayer for JP*.

John & Eileen, Thank you for your uplifting letter and your studies! It's a warm feeling to know there's people out there praying for not only me but my other brothers in Christ incarcerated. God is here at ADC Tucker Unit. As I walk up and down these cold halls, I see inmates reading and sitting in prayer circles. Dear Partners,

We have started a new class at the local prison work camp. Seventeen men appeared to start the new session. Many are unbelievers. One man has taken the class twice at the main unit and once at the Work Camp. He is a great promoter of the class, asking if there was anything new. Yes, of course, always something new. However, there in no chapel at the Camp. The old Tar Paper Cathedral, as it was called, has been closed, I believe since hurricane Charlie. All the classes are being held in the Visiting Park. And I do mean 'visiting park' with traffic in and out and very noisy vending machines. Also the white board, which I use, has been removed to another location. The first week was very different.

Yesterday, Monday, I had a once in a lifetime experience at the second class. It seems that feeding is slow at the Work Camp and the men are not able to come to class by 1:30pm. A guard walked over after I took the roll, checked my roster, then called each dorm to release the 5 inmates still missing. I murmured, 'Your have such great power! Thank you!" Then he smiled and walked out of the room. All the inmates arrived. I remarked my appreciation for what he had done to the class and they soundly applauded him. What a blessing!

Because the white board that we ordered had not arrived, I decided to show a film and chose a film by Dr. Holly of MAMA (Mothers Against Methamphetamine). I actually did not remember exactly what was in it but I am thinking the Holy Spirit knew. In it she carefully and medically explains addiction, but at the end she preached the gospel in wonderful language of the hurt and pain of addiction, the wounded and the sin of worshipping pleasure. The men were cheering her. They thought it was wonderful and she was some preacher. It gave so many men some serious things to consider. All in all, it was a glorious day. I love those kinds of days, all orchestrated by God.

This Wednesday is Margie Lee's last day as a volunteer for us. Previously from the Dallas area, she is returning there to be near her daughter. She was blessed with 2 new knees while with us. We'll miss her and wish her the best. It seems like we have had the greatest turnover of volunteers since July of last year: Bonnie, Roger, Mike, and now Margie. All on Wednesday! Lots of things get done on Wednesday, our 'work' day. All our lesson packets are put together, all tracts stamped, large envelopes stamped, bibles wrapped, tracts folded, little cards folded and any other job that needs to be done. All this besides the outgoing and the incoming Wednesday mail. Wednesday is also the day we prepare all the weeks lessons, weighing and sorting them and then putting through the machine along with all the bibles to be sent out that week. They work hard and do a super job, especially with the new mail machine.

I want to thank all of you who support this ministry. It is hard to put into words how appreciative the men and women are who receive your love through us. Please keep our lambs in your prayers. We always have changes, but we have no clue how many changes they must go through on a daily basis. We love you and thank you so very much for your prayers as well as your support!
